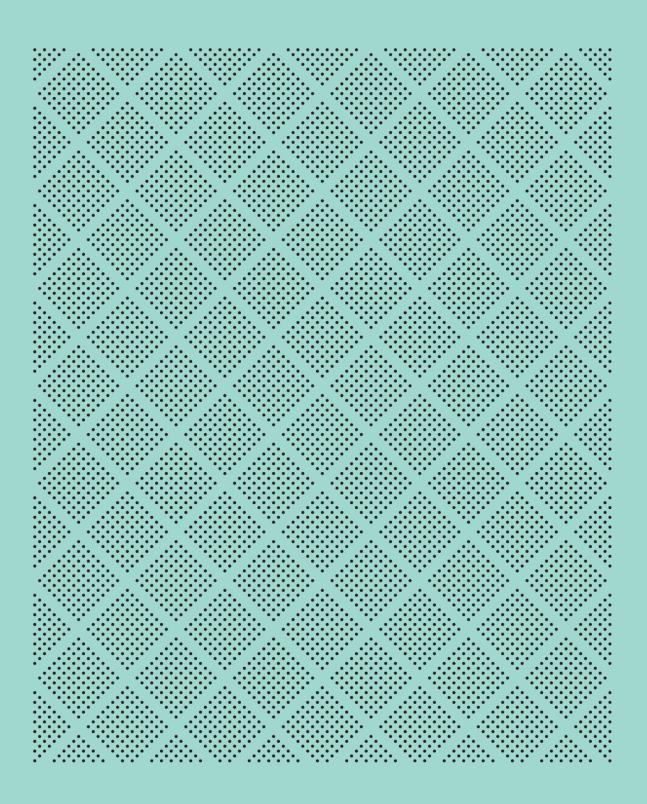

Mint Diversified Income Fund

Investment Objective

This is a multi-asset class Fund that offers diversification by investing across a number of asset classes both in New Zealand and internationally. The objective of the Fund is to deliver a total return (through a combination of income and capital growth) in excess of the Consumers Price Index (CPI) by 3% per annum, before fees, over the medium to long term.

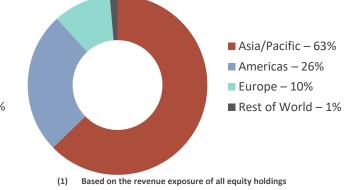

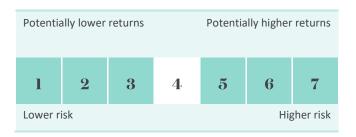

Investment Objective

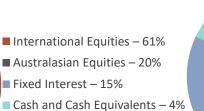

The Fund invests primarily in New Zealand and international equities (including listed property if held) but will also hold cash and fixed interest securities. The objective of the Fund is to deliver returns in excess of the Consumers Price Index (CPI) by 4.5% per annum, before fees, over the medium to long term.

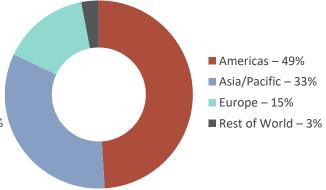

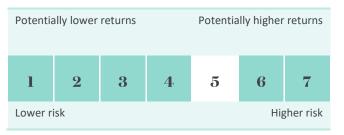


Geographic Diversification⁽²⁾
